Richmond City Hall is comprised of four major building components, creating an ensemble of public spaces. The major conceptual theme for this project was driven by the fact that the city of Richmond is an island community. Water features significantly into the design, while the berms around the site are representative of the dikes that protect this low-lying island.
